what is Hales House?

Hales House provide supported accommodation for 20 young people and in 5 'move on' properties in Pontypool and Cwmbran.

what support do we provide?

Our support workers are able to offer you support which might include:

- A resettlement package - helping you move into the community
- Preparation for independence
- Building confidence and self esteem
- Budgeting, benefits and money advice
- Setting up and organising your daily routine
- Dealing with relationships
- Support to attend meetings
- Individual and group activities
- Help and advice on education, training and employment
- Support to link in with other agencies

what else can you expect from living at Hales House?

Compass:

Access to in-house education, training and volunteering. Gain employment skills or move on to other opportunities.

H2H reward scheme:

Attend scheme activities and workshops to score points towards rewards.

Workshops include:

Safer relationships, neighbour issues, sexual health, drug and alcohol awareness, budgeting and money management.
