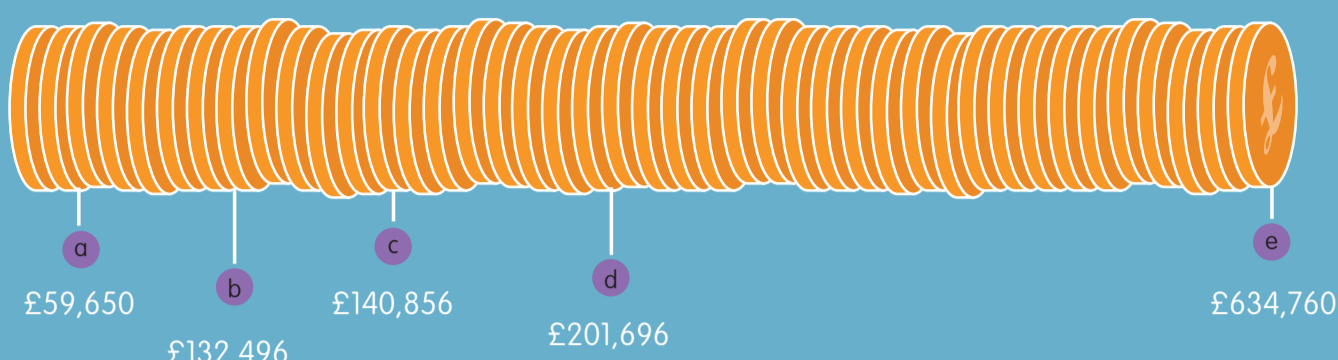


LASTING SOLUTIONS OUTCOME EVALUATION

FAMILY INTERVENTION PROJECT

Lasting Solutions is an innovative Family Intervention Project (FIP) which was established in November 2010. The service offers intensive and holistic support for troubled and vulnerable families. Since its inception the project has provided support for 16 families, 8 of which are currently still active and 2 families are about to join. The average length of provision is 10.2 months.

SUMMARY OF COST SAVINGS



Total saving - £1,169,780

- a Preventing a 6 month custodial sentence in a secure unit
- b Four children are not re-registered for CPR
- c Successful tenancies for 14 families at risk of homelessness/ eviction
- d 12 of 16 households disengaged from antisocial behaviour
- e Preventing seven family members from becoming NEET

COST EFFICIENCY



Compared to similar services offering intensive whole family support, Lasting Solutions is highly cost efficient. The average cost per family is £970 per month.

It is 2.17 times more cost efficient than the average of the DCLG evaluation of 6 FIPs.

IMPROVEMENTS



The key improvement identified by partners and families was to **expand the service to deliver greater support to more families.**

CONCLUSIONS



Significant impact in addressing issues with health, particularly around mental health, with 14 families accessing support for mental health needs.

CONCLUSIONS



For every £1 of investment, at least 5.2 times savings have been generated since project inception.
