PROJECT Working with households at risk of homelessness due to Anti Social Behaviour

TOP PREVENTION

We have reduced **Substance Misuse** and prevented 94% of adults and young people becoming involved in or

continuing to engage in

criminal behaviour

88% of young people and adults were supported to address **Familial** Domestic Abuse

We have reduced Neighbour **Complaints** 70% of ASB stopped 26% of ASB minimised

CASE STUDY

Jones Household: .Caldicot Estate **ASB** concerns

In the home

- . Familial domestic abuse
- . 25+ police calls a month
- . Alcohol misuse
- . Drug misuse (M Cat)



Daughter Hannah, 12

. Abusive to neighbours

- . Mental health problems
- . Mum unemployed
- . Young people NEET

In the Community/ Gang

- . Drug running
- . Intimidation
- . Theft from local shops
- . Defacing properties
- . Violence on the streets




Outcomes post intervention

- . Rapid decrease in police call outs (300-0 within a year)
- . No ASB or criminal behaviour
- . Mental health diagnosed and stabilised within the household





LONGER TERM OUTGOMES







The average cost per family is £970 per month. For every £1 of investment, at least 5.2 times savings have been generated since project inception.

By working with cloesly with the police, education and social services FIPP has

saved total of £1,169.780
