

TOP PREVENTION OUTCOMES

We have reduced Substance Misuse and prevented 94% of adults and young people becoming involved in or continuing to engage in criminal behaviour

88% of young people and adults were supported to address **Familial Domestic Abuse**

We have reduced Neighbour Complaints
70% of ASB stopped
26% of ASB minimised

We have reduced **Gang Nuisance**

We have reduced **Noise Nuisance**

CHANGING THE TRAJECTORY

We have reduced litter and improved the state of all the properties in which we worked

100% of 14 work ready adults re-engaged in employment
100% of 32 young people and children re-engaged in education

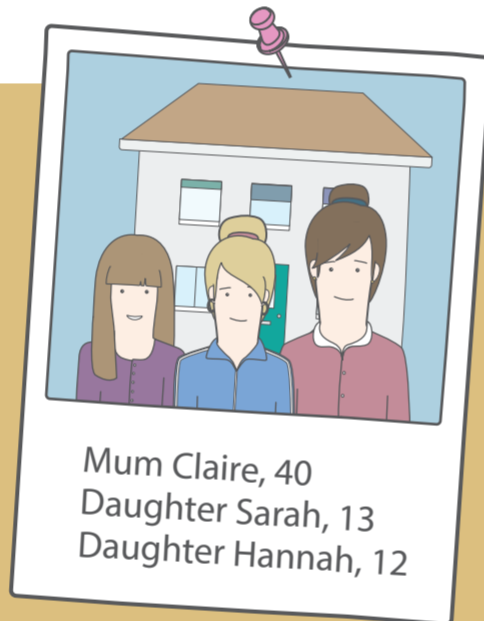
For 100% of the families we worked with, we have **Prevented a Family Breakdown**

In the home

- . Familial domestic abuse
- . 25+ police calls a month
- . Alcohol misuse
- . Drug misuse (M Cat)
- . Abusive to neighbours
- . Mental health problems
- . Mum unemployed
- . Young people NEET

In the Community/ Gang

- . Drug running
- . Intimidation
- . Theft from local shops
- . Defacing properties
- . Violence on the streets



Outcomes post intervention

- . Rapid decrease in police call outs (300-0 within a year)
- . No ASB or criminal behaviour
- . Mental health diagnosed and stabilised within the household

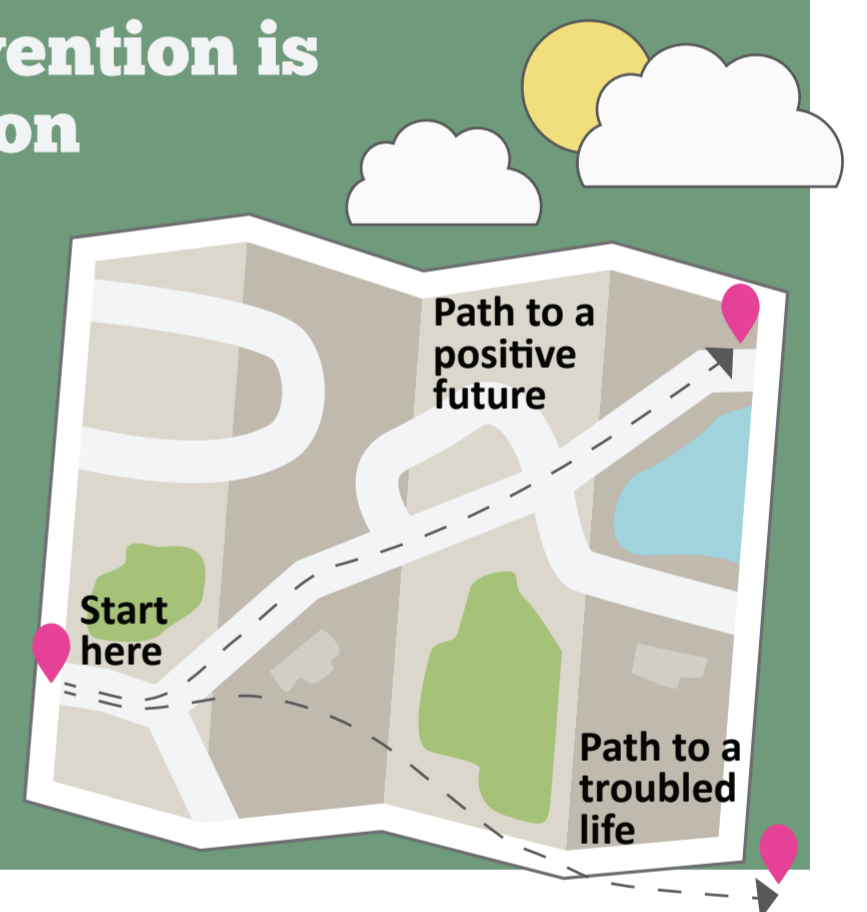


LONGER TERM OUTCOMES

Intensive intervention is early intervention and prevention

FIPP has worked with 33 adults and 45 children

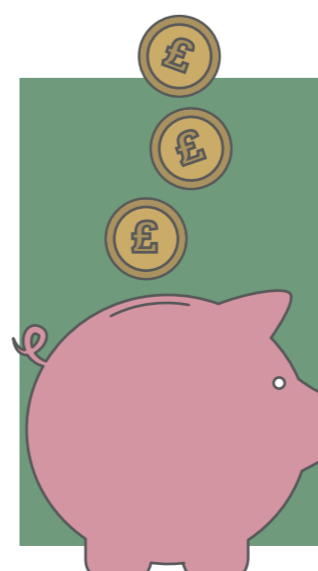
We have changed 30 families life trajectories over 5 years



We have had great success

transforming "problem areas" into safer communities

by working with multiple households and alongside other families, resulting in 'gangs' being dispersed



The average cost per family is £970 per month. For every £1 of investment, at least 5.2 times savings have been generated since project inception.

By working with closely with the police, education and social services FIPP has saved total of **£1,169.780**
